

Objective:

To practice speaking skills.

Instructions:

Divide the class into small groups of 3-5 students and give each group a set of pieces of paper with ideas for "perfect Christmas presents" (use the suggestions below or create your own). Place the pieces of paper face down.

Students take turns drawing a piece of paper and explaining why the gift listed is a perfect Christmas present and how they would use it. The gifts are a bit silly, so there are no correct answers – students should use their imagination.

The focus is on having fun and practicing speaking rather than on using perfect language.

A Snowball Launcher

A machine that makes snowballs even in the summer

Singing Socks

Socks that sing Christmas songs when you walk around

A Chocolate Fountain Shower

A shower that sprays you with chocolate when you stand under it

Santa's Magic Shoes

Shoes that make you slide across floors like you're on ice

A Reindeer Onesie

A cozy reindeer overall that makes you jump like a reindeer
